Unidirectional Capabilities

- Regularly retrieves new and revised product record information (e.g., item master, BOM, and AML records) when Arena ECOs are released
- Reads the product record information and updates the NetSuite ERP item master and BOM records, as well as the approved manufacturer when appropriate

Bidirectional Capabilities

- Provides supply chain information like cost and inventory information from NetSuite back to Arena

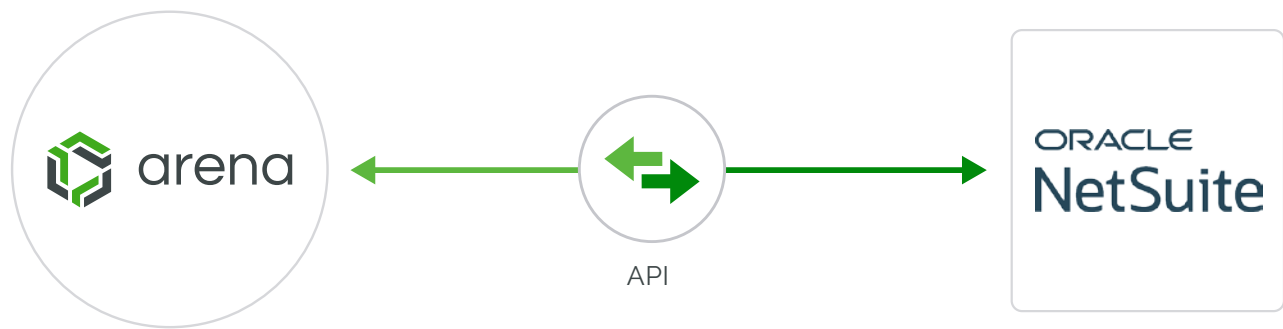

- The Arena–NetSuite ERP Integration uses the latest APIs to fetch item data from Arena and to create and update records in NetSuite
- The integration makes calls directly from NetSuite to Arena's APIs, so no middleware is required and there are no middleware-related security concerns
- Integration can be automated to run as frequently as every 15 minutes
- Integration can be triggered manually with specific date and item parameters
- Secure deployment with no corporate firewall configuration changes required
- Easy to configure and implement

Error Handling and Data Validation

- Sequential data processing with built-in data validation to ensure accurate and complete data transfer every time
- Continual monitoring of product data updates and error alerts
- Easy access to error records enables quick corrective actions after corrections are completed
